Dear Sir I am writing

life can afford. I had to leave without  
calling you up as I promised you  
I would. I tried to get you over the  
phone but could not. All tho. I am  
here but I hope I won't have to stay  
very long you are the only hope I  
have of ever getting out and if  
things come in our favor I am  
sure I will get out soon and  
if you do I am making 40¢ a day  
and some days I can make as  
high as \$1.00 a day and I am saving  
it they won't let you spend any  
money away but I will make it  
~~the~~ payable to you on my release  
that is all I can be sure of because  
I can not depend on my people for  
any thing you see that for it takes  
all they can make to live down  
there I have found that out
